



The Adorkable Hedgehog Mr. Redge



Step One

Assemble your supplies:

- 2 dark pieces of felt
- 1 light piece of felt
- black embroidery floss/needle
- black pom pom (or vintage button)
- googly eyes (or felt)
- dry beans
- fiberfill



Two Using template, cut out pieces and mark facial details.

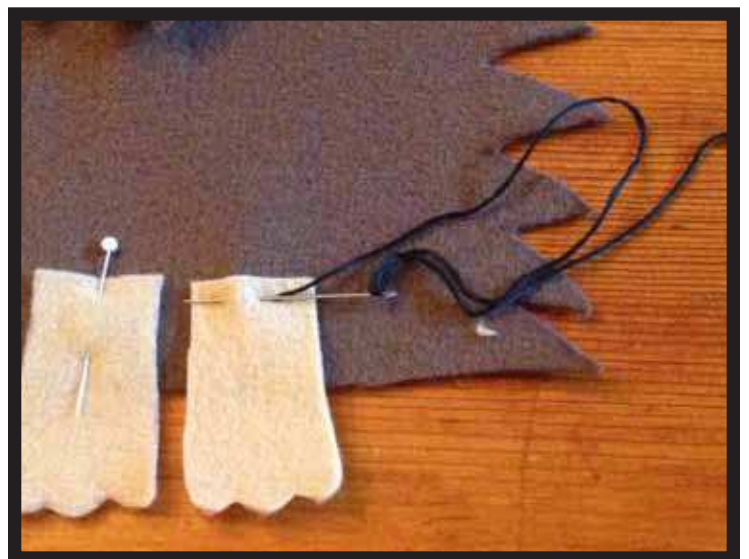
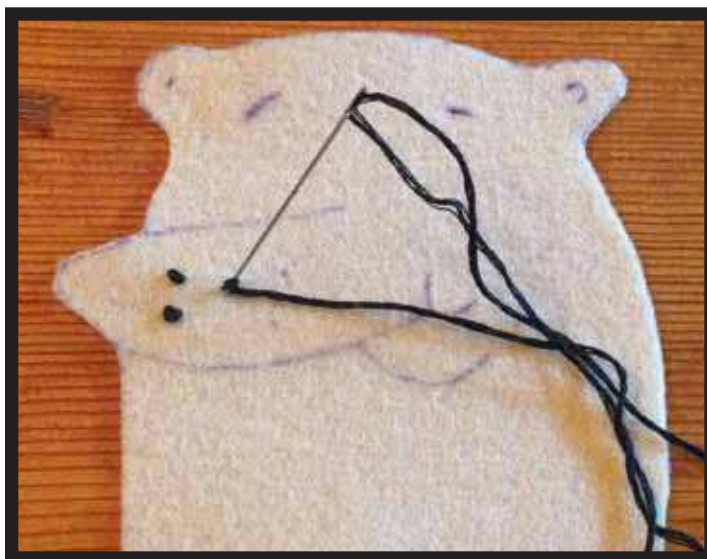

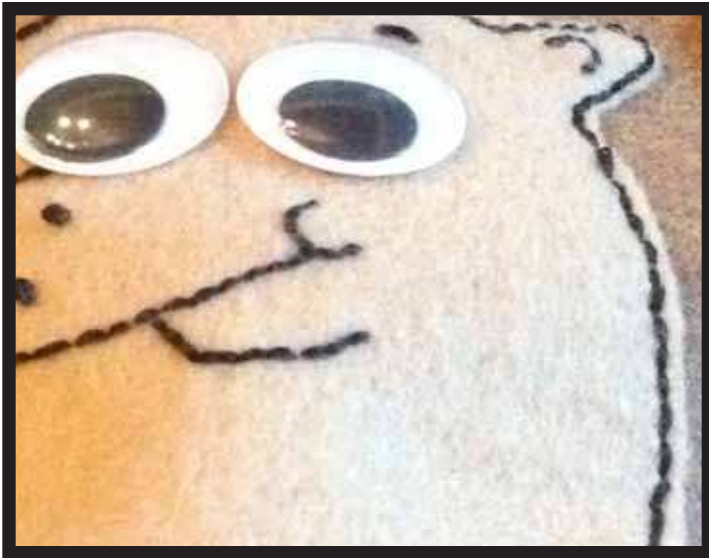
Using 6-strands of black floss, stitch facial details:

- French knots for freckles
- back stitch for nose, mouth, ears and eye brows

Using template as guide, fold and attach Mr. Redge's bangs to a spike piece with a straight stitch.

Five Place feet on same spike piece and attach with a straight stitch.



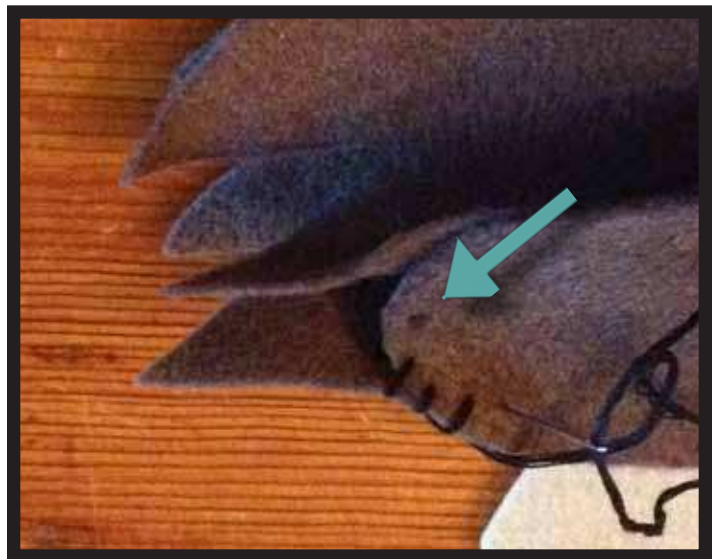


Six

Place body on top of feet and underneath the bangs and use back-stitch to attach to the spike piece (refer to front cover for placement). Add googly eyes (or stitch on felt eyes if you prefer).

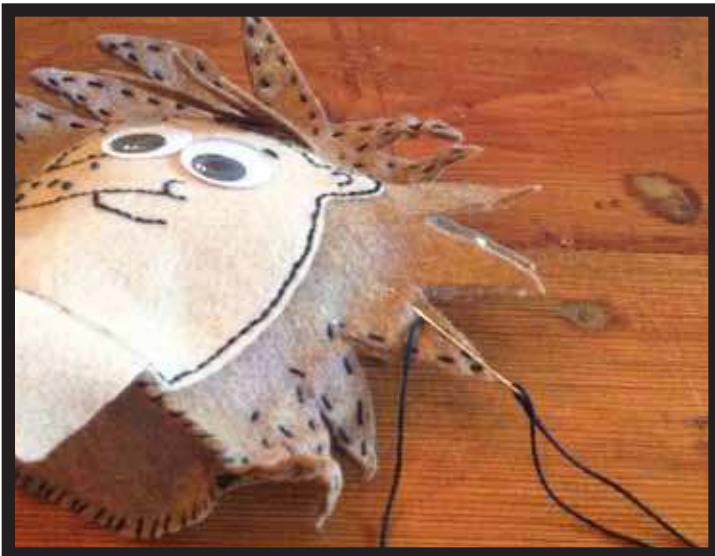
Seven

Before attaching the top and bottom spike pieces together, whip stitch base in place. Use dots to make sure the base is even on both sides.



Eight

Match spikes front to back and straight stitch them together leaving an opening in the side.



Nine

Fill the bottom with a layer of dry beans, then stuff with fiberfill. Close the opening with a straight stitch.



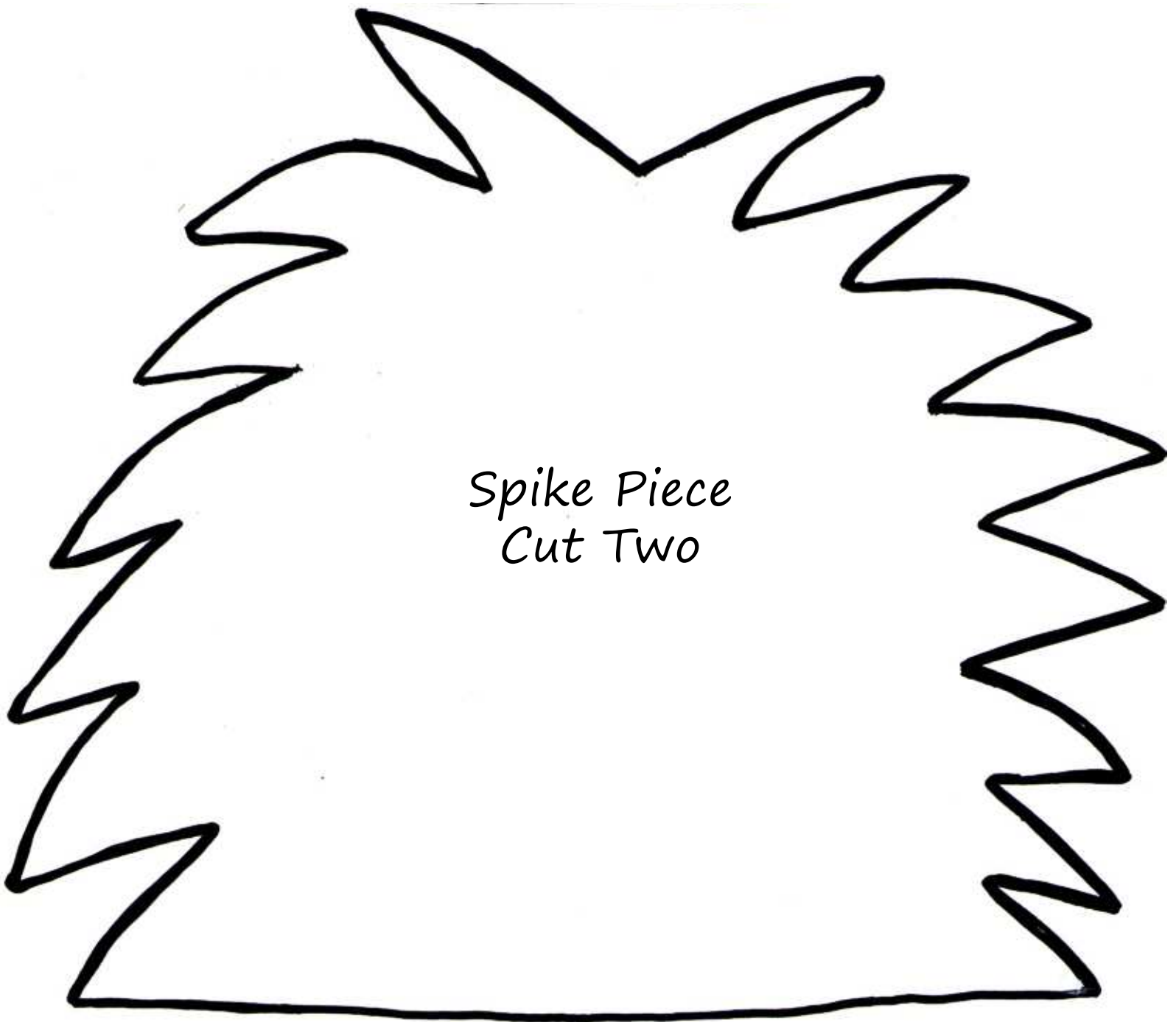

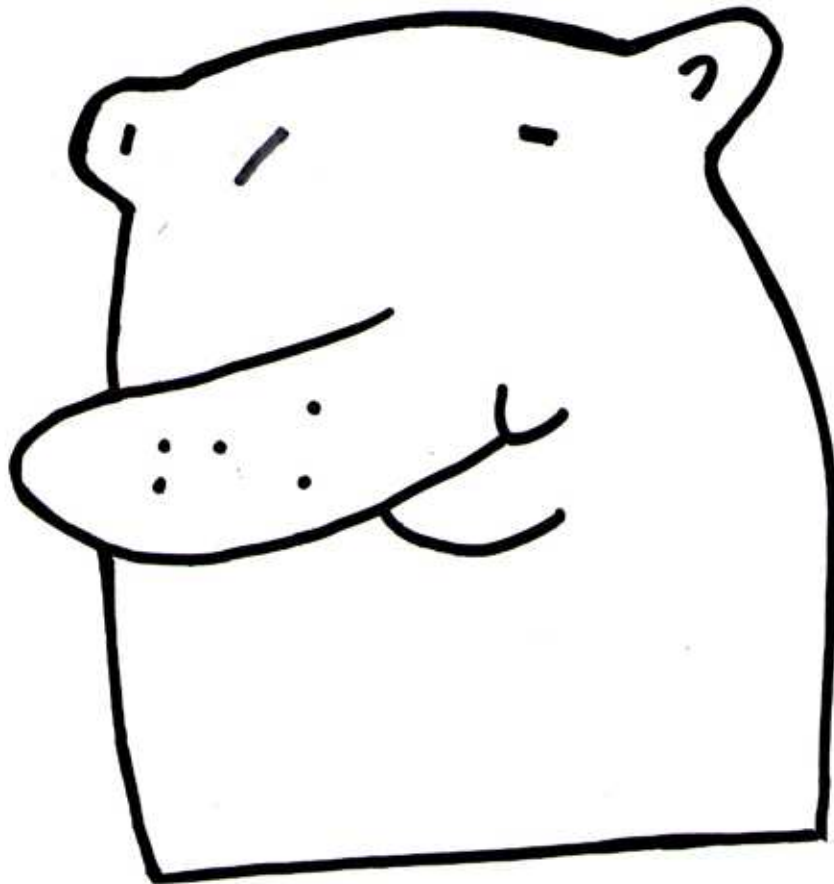

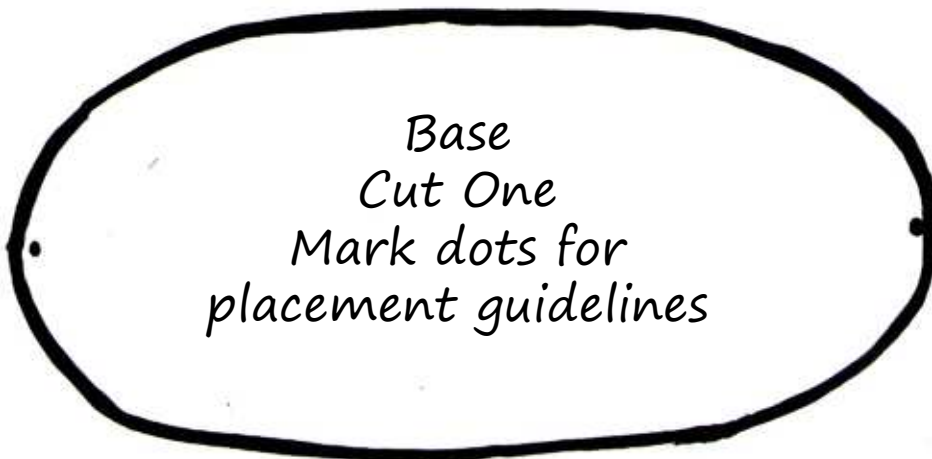
